



# Classic Scarf

Free pattern from [rockingyak.com](http://rockingyak.com)

**Yarn:** The Rocking Yak, 100% Tibetan Yak Down Yarn, 140-150yd/100g ball (need 1.5 balls)

**Gauge:** 14 sts and 21 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

**Needles:** Size 6 mm (US 10) needles

This is a simple pattern that adds elegance and warmth to your wardrobe. It is a great pattern for beginners and looks great when finished.

## Instructions

Cast on 27 sts.

Row 1: (K3, P3), repeat 3 more times, K3.

Row 2: (P3, K3), repeat 3 more times, P3.

Row 3: Same as Row 1.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Repeat rows 1 – 6 until the scarf is desired length (approx. 55-60"/140-150 cm) ending with row 6.

Cast off loosely.

**Option:** Use Rocking Yak, 100% Tibetan Yak Down Yarn, Snow Mountain Series yarn (about 210yd/100g) in whatever colour you like. Need 1.5 balls.

**Gauge:** 21 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st on 4 mm (US 8) needles

**Needles:** 4 mm (US 8) needles



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
