



Winter Cable Scarf

Free pattern from rockingyak.com

Yarn: The Rocking Yak, 100% Tibetan Yak Down Yarn, 150yd/100g ball (need 2 balls)

Gauge: 13 sts and 19 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

Needles: Size 5.5 mm (US 10.5) needles

Abbreviations

C4F – put 2 sts on cable needle and put to front. Knit next 2 sts, then knit sts on cable needle.

TW2 – slip next 2 sts together knitwise on right needle – they will twist into reverse order. Slide back on left needle, one at a time. Knit.

Instructions

Cast on 30 sts.

Row 1: (WS) [P2, K2] twice P4, K2, P2, K2, P4, [K2, P2] twice.

Row 2: [K2,P2] twice, K4, P2, TW2, P2, K4, [P2, K2] twice.

Row 3: Same as Row 1.

Row 4: [K2,P2] twice, C4F, P2, TW2, P2, C4F, [P2, K2] twice.

Repeat rows 1 – 4 until the scarf is desired length (approx. 55-60"/140-150 cm) ending with row 4.

Cast off.

To make the fringe, wrap yarn around cardboard that is approx. 5.5" [15cm] in width for 52 times. Cut the yarn at one end of the cardboard. Take 2 strands together and fold in half. Using a crochet hook, pull the loop a little way through the end of the scarf. Put ends of the strands through loop and pull snugly. Repeat (26 fringes x 2 strands), spreading the fringe evenly at the each of the scarf.



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
